Six large (standard) sand arenas for all classes. Tentative Schedule of Classes is now posted on NEDA website; it will be updated after classes are scheduled in late August.

- (1) Specify and pay additional \$50 Sweepstakes entry fee (covers both required rides) to be included in Sweepstakes. See Sweepstakes description below.
- (2) Para Equestrian and FEI / USDF Freestyles will be ridden back to back in large arena Ring 1, main arena late Saturday afternoon. USDF freestyles: First, Second, Third or Fourth Level. . FEI freestyles: Pony Riders, Juniors, Young Riders, Intermediate 1, Grand Prix. Not FEI Recognized; FEI Saddlery Rules apply. Passport not required. No jog. Special consideration for other USDF musical test such as Pas de Deux and Quadrille
- (3) Not FEI Recognized; FEI Saddlery Rules apply. Passport not required. No jog. On Thursday USEF FEI classes will be completed prior to the FEI Jog. No freestyle tests; no Para Equestrian tests. All other FEI tests (except FEI 4 Year Old Young Horse) may be ridden. Specify test clearly on Entry Form. FEI Pony tests must be ridden by a junior (12 – 16). Ponies will not be measured. Entries to any Young Horse test will be scored and pinned separately as another class. Young Horse Tests allowed: USEF Four Year Old Test; FEI Five Year Old Preliminary Test; FEI Five Year Old Final Test; FEI Six Year Old Preliminary Test; FEI Six Year Old Final Test.
- (4) Qualifying class for 2011 Great American Insurance Group / United States Dressage Federation Regional Dressage Championship recognized by United States Equestrian Federation Inc.. Include \$10 (beyond entry fee) to have ride score reported. Only classes so specified may be used as qualifiers.
- (5) USDF / Dover Saddlery Adult Amateur Medal class. Open class. The Medal will be presented to the highest scoring Adult Amateur (58% or better) who meets these requirements: rider is current USDF group, participating, or intercollegiate / interscholastic member at time medal is awarded; no membership requirement for owner of horse; horse need not be USDF Lifetime registered; rider possesses USEF Senior Amateur card or USEF Non-Member Amateur card. See www.usdf.org for additional program details.
- (6) Not FEI Recognized. FEI Rules for Para Equestrians apply. Passport not required. No jog. Submit Para Equestrian documentation with Entry. Only FEI Para Equestrian tests allowed. Class 161 TOC, Class 261 TOC and Class 361 Freestyle will be held in 20m x 60m ring. Therefore, Class 361 Freestyle for Grade IV riders only. Classes 161 and 261 for Grades I, II, III and IV riders. See General Competition Specifications in this Official Prize List for details.
- (7) Current USEF National Young Adult "Brentina Cup" Test. For Young Adults: riders are eligible from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 20 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 28.

**JUNIOR / YOUNG RIDER DIVISION AWARDS
ADULT AMATEUR DIVISION AWARDS**

Separate ribbons, in addition to regular ribbons, for each Division (Junior/Young Rider Division and Adult Amateur Division) given in every class where highest score in Division is 58% or better. Specify Jr/YR Division (per USEF GR115/120) or Adult Amateur Division (per USEF GR808) on Entry Form. USEF Adult Amateur membership and copy of current membership card required for Adult Amateur Division; USEF membership is not required for Jr/YR Division. NEDA membership not required. JrYR and Adult Amateurs will be designated in show program.

**NEW ENGLAND DRESSAGE FALL FESTIVAL
DRESSAGE SWEEPSTAKES**

There are five Sweepstakes competitions: Training, First, Second, Third and Fourth Level. Sweepstakes competitors enter the two highest Open classes of their level, the first on Thursday and the second on Friday. Pay additional \$50 fee to compete for cash awards. Sweepstakes classes, therefore, are a combination of Open and Sweepstakes riders. A horse may compete only at one level. A rider may ride no more than two horses in each level. The same rider must ride both tests. Whips allowed. Tests may be called. All riders (JrYR, Adult Amateur, Open); no residency, membership, or qualifying scores required. Placing determined by totaling each ride's final percentage then dividing by two. Ties broken by highest scoring second ride. Entrants are designated in Show Program.. See Awards specifications in General Specifications section.

**NEW ENGLAND DRESSAGE FALL FESTIVAL
JUNIOR / YOUNG RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP
ADULT AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP**

Specify Jr/YR Division (per USEF DR115/120 of USEF rules) or Adult Amateur Division (per USEF DR808 of USEF rules) on Entry Form. USEF Adult Amateur membership and copy of current membership card required for Adult Amateur Division; USEF membership is not required for Jr/YR Division. NEDA membership not required. JrYR and Adult Amateurs will be designated in show program. Any protest concerning an entrant's eligibility to JrYR or Adult Amateur Division must be filed in writing, with signature, at Headquarters by noon on Saturday. Show management will make final decision as to an entrant's eligibility. Competitors may enter both Sweepstakes and either of these Championships.

Competitor need not apply for JrYR of Adult Amateur Championship. For all JrYR and Adult Amateur competitors, all rides actually ridden on Thursday, Friday, and / or Saturday will be eligible. No Freestyle (or other musical rides) or FEI Young Horse scores will be considered. No Breed Show scores will be considered. Otherwise, all rides from CDI, Regional Championships, and Open Dressage Show will be considered.

Winners will be selected using only the highest percentage score of each rider regardless of horse. Scores from each eligible ride will be ranked in order. Only the highest score per rider will be considered; a rider can place only once. In case of tie, the higher level test will take precedence. Six highest scoring riders in each Division will receive championship ribbon and cash award: 1st \$400 / 2nd \$300 / 3rd \$200 / 4th \$100 / 5th \$50 / 6th \$25. Awards will be mailed to Owner on Entry Form (be sure address is valid!) if winners are not present to pick them up.
